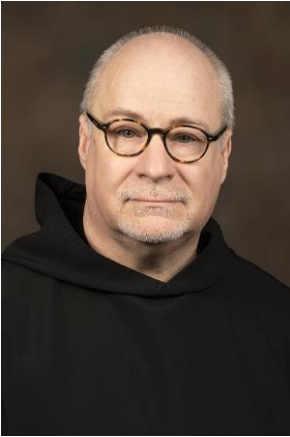


Welcome from the President-Rector

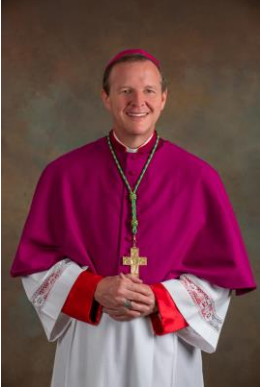

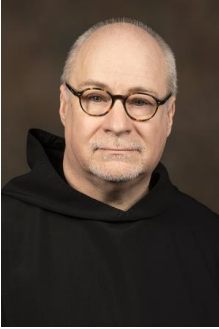
